

A Message from Bishop McKnight

Public Masses suspended immediately

A message from Bishop W. Shawn McKnight | March 17, 2020

Dear sisters and brothers in Christ,

I know you join me in concern for all who are being affected by the rapid spread of the coronavirus. Today, I am announcing that all public Masses will be suspended in the Diocese of Jefferson City, beginning on Wednesday, March 18 and until at least April 3.

This is in keeping with the federal directives and other public entities in our area. We offer this decision as part of our effort to help stem the spread of the coronavirus.

This means all Catholics are dispensed from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass in person. Online opportunities are listed on our website, and some parishes will be able to provide online Masses. Catholics are encouraged to check with their local parish regarding online Masses.

In addition, parishes have been instructed to make the following changes, beginning March 18:

- All public gatherings are cancelled or postponed. This includes public weddings. More information on baptisms, funerals and other liturgical protocols can be found here.
- Confirmation Masses will be rescheduled to be celebrated after Easter Sunday.
- During this time, churches will remain open as places of prayer and comfort. Priests will be available in the parishes to offer anointing of the sick and other sacraments. You are encouraged to seek the sacrament of anointing of the sick before you go to the hospital, if possible.
- I ask you to be mindful of your responsibility to serve the community in your time, talent and treasure in this extraordinary hour of need. You may register your volunteer capacity on our website. Parishes are organizing disaster responder teams to serve those immediately impacted by the coronavirus pandemic. Please continue your tithes to your parishes by postal mail or online, if the parish offers that option.
- Diocesan schools, which are suspending in-school instruction from March 18 to April 3, are providing ongoing instruction either online or packet-based, on a case-by-case basis. While diocesan offices and parish offices will remain open, some employees may work remotely or need to take leave to care for themselves or their families. Some parishes may reduce office hours. Regardless, all diocesan and parish employees will continue to receive compensation.

I am grateful to all who are working tirelessly to mitigate the effects of the pandemic. I pray the efforts we are doing, as a people of faith, will provide tangible support, encouragement and spiritual hope to our communities.





CONTINUING YOUR SUNDAY TITHE

As public Masses are temporarily suspended, we are working to serve you, albeit in a new way, during these trying times. In the Bishop's instructions to the faithful of the diocese, he has asked us to continue our Sunday offertory tithe by postal mail or electronic means.

If you are already giving through EFT (electronic funds transfer) or through your credit/debit card online, your gift will continue as you have previously set it up. Thank you for your commitment to the parish through this giving option.

If you are accustomed to giving to the offertory through cash or your envelopes, I ask that you take steps to continue your gift in one of the following ways:

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)

EFT is Newman's most preferred electronic giving option because it is the only option which allows you to incur no transaction fees while setting up a recurring (once or twice monthly) gift. To begin this option, please fill out the form included to the right and return to Newman with a voided check. You can either email this information to Angie Claas in our business office (angie@ **comonewman.org**) or print and mail (with your voided check) to:

Please make sure the entire form is filled out, especially the start date and which withdrawal date(s) you want (you can do first Friday, third Friday, or both). If you have questions, feel free to reach out to Angie and she will be happy to help you with the process.

Credit/Debit Card or Bank Account through online giving

This option provides a bit more flexibility for you, allowing you to choose a recurring gift for any day of the month. You can use your credit/debit card or your bank account, but each incurs fees (from 1%-3%, depending on your payment venue). You can sign up online at comonewman.breezechms.com/give/online.

Venmo — a PayPal app

You can also make fee-free transactions to Newman through the Venmo app, which is owned by PayPal. If you are new to Venmo, it takes a few minutes to get connected to your bank account, but once it is configured, you can make easy and quick gifts to Newman. Venmo does not offer a recurring option. If you choose to give in this way, please make sure you search @comonewman and ensure that our Newman logo is in the profile image. There are several St. Thomas More Newman Centers on Venmo — make sure you have the right one!

If you would prefer to mail a check to Newman, you can do so through USPS by mailing to Angie Claas in the business office (address listed above). Please DO NOT send cash. Checks or money orders are always preferred when sending gifts through



2020 Parish Renewal Program **Summary Results**






Program participation from those who currently support the parish through time and/or treasure.
