We build a life rooted in faith.

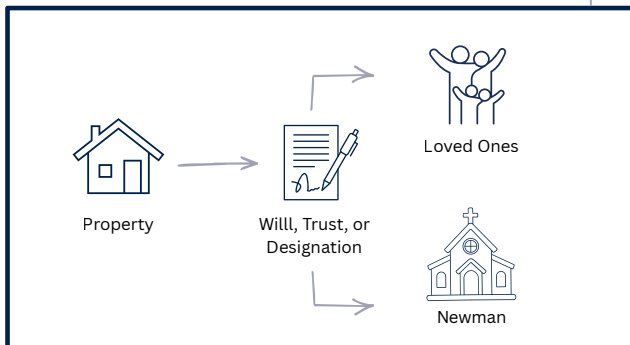
But one day, every one of us will ask the same question:
